
Service on the Illini® and Saluki®

Bicycles and Golf Bags: A limited number of spaces are available to transport unboxed bicycles and golf bags to/from all stations served by the Illini and Saluki trains (not available on trains 58 and 59). Reservations are required; nominal charges apply; passenger assists with loading, stowing and unloading.

Chicago Transit Authority (CTA) rapid transit trains provide frequent service to O'Hare and Midway Airports. Blue Line trains to O'Hare leave from the subway station at the corner of Clinton and Congress Streets, two blocks south of Union Station. Orange Line trains to Midway leave from the elevated station at the corner of Quincy and Wells streets, three blocks east of Union Station. Pay fare in CTA station.
