The *Texas Eagle* serves all stations between Chicago and San Antonio daily. Through service west of San Antonio operates tri-weekly, departing Chicago, Poplar Bluff and intermediate stations on Sundays, Tuesdays and Fridays. Eastbound trains departing Los Angeles on Sunday, Wednesday and Friday arrive Dallas on Tuesday, Friday and Sunday, and stations between Walnut Ridge-Chicago on Wednesday, Saturday and Monday.

Trails and Rails Program: In cooperation with the National Park Service, volunteer rangers from the San Antonio Missions National Historical Park provide a narrative between Fort Worth and San Antonio, on select days, May 24 through September 2; volunteers from the Lincoln Home National Historic Site provide a narrative between Chicago and Springfield, on select days, May 24 through September 30. 
- Coaches: Reservations required.**
